



SELF DECLARATION FOR ACCESS TO PREMISES

I the undersigned _____ (name) _____ (surname) _____ (fiscal code) by signing this document declare is fully aware of and agrees to comply with the rules contained in the anti-accounting protocols adopted by the University, which can also be consulted online at <https://multiblog.uniupo.it/news/covid-misure-la-riapertura/misure-di-protezione-la-riapertura-dell%E2%80%99upo>

On the occasion of all access to the University's premises, the undersigned undertakes to comply with all the provisions contained in the protocols adopted by the University relating to access and stay in the premises, and in particular to the respect of hygiene and health regulations, the use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and the respect of safety distances.

On the occasion of all future access to the University facilities, the undersigned undertakes NOT to enter the University premises in case of:

- coming from areas considered to be at epidemiological risk as identified by the OMS;
- contacts, in the 14 days prior to access, with subjects with positive results at COVID-19;
- body temperature above 37.5°C or other flu symptoms.

The undersigned also undertakes to inform promptly and responsibly, ensuring maximum collaboration, the staff duly appointed, of the presence of any influenza symptoms found during the stay at the University premises, taking care to stay at a suitable distance from the people present.

I also commit myself to communicate any confirmation of positivity to Covid-19 to the University Covid Contact Person, Mr Valerio Marinucci (valerio.marinucci@uniupo.it), if it occurs within 8 days after attending the University premises.

Information on personal data processing

In addition to the information on the processing of personal data you already received, the Università degli Studi del Piemonte Orientale "Amedeo Avogadro" informs you that your personal data will be processed for the correct implementation of the Covid-19 anti-accounting safety protocols provided for by law, the protection of the health of people entering the premises and in particular the prevention of contagion from COVID-19 and the collaboration with public authorities and, in particular, health authorities (legal basis: art. 6 (1) (c) GDPR for common data and art. 9 (2) (h) and (i) GDPR for data belonging to special categories). The relevant legal provisions on which the processing carried out are based are identified in the combined provisions of Art. 1 (7) (d) of the Ministerial Decree of 11 March 2020 and the rules contained in the shared Protocol 14 March 2020, Protocol 24 April 2020 and subsequent additions and amendments. The University may also process data to assert or defend a right in court and for the management of litigation, for example in the event of disputes. The legal basis for such processing is the University's need to see its own rights or those of third parties protected in court (legal basis: Art. 9 (2) (f) GDPR). The required identification data are kept until the end of the state of emergency foreseen by the competent public authorities. This is without prejudice to retention for a longer period in relation to requests by the Health Authorities. It is without prejudice to the retention of personal data, even particular data, for a longer period, within the limits of the statute of limitations of rights, in relation to requirements related to the exercise of the right of defence in case of disputes.
